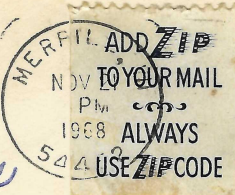

& happy new year

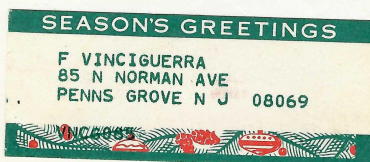
